This workshop will focus on how the principles of Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) and corresponding evidence-based treatments can be utilized by anyone (e.g., parents, teachers, therapists, family members, friends, counselors, private providers) to prevent and/or reactively manage aggressive and other severe problem behaviors (e.g., self-injurious, destructive, health-concerning or threatening) with adolescents and adults. This population inherently brings challenges less, or not, present with newly diagnosed or young children with an Intellectual and/or Developmental Disability. It's these challenges faced by many parents and others today that often lead to emergency personnel or police involvement, hospitalizations (medical and/or psychiatric), and/or potential removal from their home or current environment. This workshop will not only explain best-practices in managing aggressive behavior within this population but will additionally involve modeling by the presenter, role-plays by attendees, and handouts. **Previous attendance at an ABC's of ABA is strongly suggested** to allow attendees to move past the basics of behavior analysis.
